

National Average Drug Acquisition Cost (NADAC)

The Federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) contracted with a national certified public accounting firm to conduct surveys of retail community pharmacy prices, including drug ingredient costs, to develop the National Average Drug Acquisition Cost (NADAC) pricing benchmark. The NADAC pricing data is available at data.medicaid.gov.

Effective for claims processed on and after April 1, 2017, the ingredient cost for pharmacy claims submitted to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services will be paid at the lesser of NADAC, Wholesale Acquisition Cost, Maximum Allowable Cost, or the provider's usual and customary charge to the general public minus any other insurance and/or other monies collected toward the claim.

If recent drug price changes are not reflected in posted NADAC files, pharmacy providers may notify the NADAC Help Desk. The NADAC Help Desk can be contacted through the following means:
